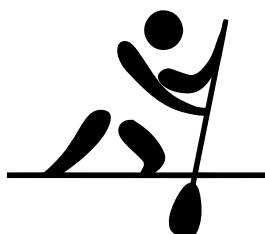

Welcome to Kris and Naomi Kenyon, who have purchased the shop in Frogmore.

Kris has worked in hospitality for nearly two decades and this is where he and Naomi met, working together in St Austel Brewery owned Old Market House in Brixham 10 years ago. They have worked together in various places over the years including the Sea Horse Restaurant in Dartmouth where Kris held the position of Deputy Manager.



Kris and Naomi provide great coffee (namely Voyager – Road Trip blend), and wonderful savouries, sandwiches, pasties and cakes. They also have a gluten free range too. Eggs, butter, milk and cheese can also be purchased along with a growing range of other daily essentials.

They are in the process of providing more local food such as local honey, jams and marmalades. They will soon be providing Heron Valley fruit juices, local cider and South Hams Brewery beer. They will also have bread available to purchase within the near future.

Already stocked are olive oils, wine vinegars, grilled artichokes, anchovies, olives and other delicacies.

Kris has a stock of wine in the shop and aims to improve this over time to a much wider range. You can always ask Kris if he can source a wine for you if you are looking for something specific.

There is room to sit in the shop and have a leisurely coffee or drink and the décor inside the shop is beautiful and provides a lovely ambience.

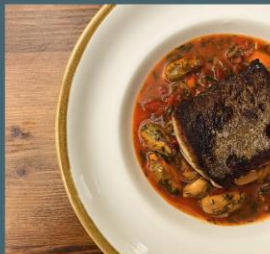
So why not stop by and have a drink and sandwich/pastie or treat yourself to a cake!
