We are looking forward to seeing you then.

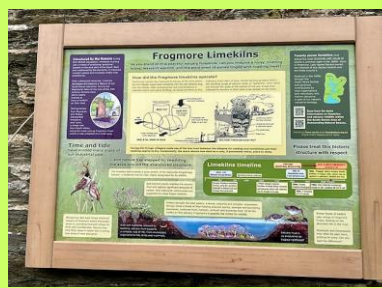
